The largest ski resort in Switzerland and the highest city in Europe, Davos has something for everyone. Davos is one of 12 classic Alpine resorts which have joined to form the "Best of the Alps" Group. They represent the most prestigious winter sports destinations. Davos boasts the following facts:

- 57 lifts, with a capacity of over 60,000 persons/hour
- 191 miles of trails and limitless off piste terrain.
- Top elevation is 8,785 ft, and its lowest, 3,930 feet, high enough to be snow sure, low enough to avoid altitude sickness.
- 20% beginner, 44 % intermediate, and 36% advanced/expert.
- 50 miles of cross country trails
- 60 miles of winter walking trails

Your ski pass gives you access to this entire area; from the main **Parsenn** area journey to **Schatzalp** where a cable car spans an enormous chasm lining the area to the summit. Parsenn offers steeps as well as miles of long and interesting intermediate slopes. You can take the six mile journey to fairytale Klosters The runs drop more than a vertical mile. The advanced eight mile run from Weissfluh to Kublis drops 6,600 vertical feet, among the longest continuous runs in the Alps. The **Jakobshorn** area has shorter but more challenging runs. Just down the road are the **Rinerhorn** and **Pischa** ski areas, offering lots of easier terrain.

The beautiful **Hotel Meierhof** is a 4* property located in the center of the resort, with a wine cellar, piano bar, fireplace lounge, sauna, indoor pool, whirlpool, steam bath, fitness room and massage. Walk to the Parsenn lift, or take the free ski bus 10 yards from the hotel. Or take a day off and travel to nearby St. Moritz to ski or sightsee, or the historic city of Chur. Off the slopes, you can take advantage of the many activities such as ice skating on Europe's largest outdoor rink, snowshoeing, sledding, cross country trails, and winter walking trails. Or try ice surfing and climbing, paragliding or hang gliding!
