This unique ski area interconnects 12 resorts in France and Switzerland, passing from villages of Savoie to the landscapes of the Valais; **one lift ticket does it all** (no supplements for cross-border skiing and riding). Loosely translated, "Portes du Soleil" means "gateway to the sun", and the vibrant Rhone-Alps town of Morzine is the main portal to this incredibly large ski circus. Via its state of the art modern lift and trail connection with adjacent Avoriaz, Morzine accesses **214 lifts and 435 miles of trails linking over a dozen villages in two countries**. It just doesn't get much grander than that! Variety is the spice of skiing and the choices are many on the slopes of the Portes du Soleil. **Beginners** (30%) can stick close to the resorts and **intermediates** (30%) won't have a problem if they stay on the trails, while both the extensive off-piste skiing and the exhausting expanse will stretch **experts** (40%).

Some of the ski resorts covered by your Portes du Soleil skipass are, **Morzine-Les Gets**: head east, and you'll find yourself skiing across the border to the **Swiss part of the resort, Champéry, Les Crosets and Champoussin**. Take the ski lifts from the center of Morzine to the adjacent valley of **Ardent and Les Lindarets**. Finish your day back in France in "**Super**" **Morzine-Avoriaz**.

Champs Fleuris, our ski-in, ski-out hotel, is at the foot of the slopes in the village center. At the end of the day, relax in their outdoor, heated pool or soothe tired muscles with a massage or sauna in the fitness center. Of course, there is the hotel bar with music. A lively après ski atmosphere offers different events nightly from candlelit ski decents, to skiing thru the ages, races, free "vin chaud", fireworks, music & more. Right outside our door are many tropical bars and discos to choose from, or you may enjoy a hockey game or figure skating exhibition at the Ice Palace. There is also cross-country skiing, dog sledding and ice climbing. Morzine is close to Geneve, Annecey, Montreux, Lake Geneva and many other points of interest for day trips and activities.
