**Peace, Love, and a ton of snow:** Sugarbush's 4,000 foot peaks translate into unparalleled skiing for all abilities. The six mountains of Sugarbush encompass some 4,000 acres of incredible terrain and are connected by the world's longest, fastest chairlift: the Slide Brook Express.
