

# VAIL

## A World Class Resort

### December 15-20, 2010

Located high in the Colorado Rockies, Vail is the largest ski area in the United States with the most groomed terrain on the planet. Don't let the groomed stuff deter you back country, tree skiing dare devils, because there is plenty of rugged terrain to challenge and satisfy you too. Averaging more than 400 inches of snow a year, Vail is comprised of three distinct areas of the mountain, The Back Bowls, Blue Sky Basin and the Front Side including four terrain parks, seven bowls and 5280 acres of skiable terrain.

Stretching over seven miles, Vail's seven bowls represent only one-third of the available ski area. Featuring a vertical drop of 3,450 feet you will have the opportunity to ski on more than 193 trails. Blue Sky Basin offers the solitude of back country skiing on more than 645 acres and is located two miles from Vail civilization. The Front Side of Vail features 127 trails including long cruisers and all four terrain parks. Additionally, Vail will really move you with its 33 lifts that include a heated 12-passenger gondola speeding you to the top in eight minutes

At the base of the Mountain, Vail's Bavarian-like village commands your attention with its shops and dining. Lodging is at the Evergreen Lodge located in the center of Lionshead, just a short walk or shuttle ride to Lionshead Village and its state of the art 12-passenger Eagle Bahn Gondola. The Evergreen Lodge offers two to a room lodging (3 or 4 to a room is available...just ask for a quote). It also offers a game room, hot tub, pool, exercise room, Sports Bar and restaurant on site that offers a continental breakfast.
